

## JAA PROGRAM FACT SHEET

1. JAA is an athletic program only. However, to participate in JAA sport programs all student-athletes must be enrolled and actively participating in a full load of 12 hours of classes at an accredited college or university.
2. Cost for JAA athletic program is a separate fee from college costs. Student-athletes must pay all athletic fees prior to the first day of practice. JAA does not offer a payment plan. Payments can be made via, credit card, cash, certified bank check, App Cash, Pay Pal, or Stripe.
3. JAA cannot promise any player will get an offer, an interview or be asked to visit a D1 or D2 college. Our program will promote players based on comparisons players stats in the national recruiting field.
4. JAA coaches will evaluate players performance, willingness to be trained, improvements and skills sets in comparison to positions.
5. JAA cannot guarantee all players will start. Starting positions are earned. Player's growth and improvement on the field determines playing time.
6. Every student interested in playing sports at NCAA colleges for the first time in 2022 or any year after needs to register and create a Certification Account at NCAA Eligibility Center to have a determination if they are eligible to play. Register at [web3.ncaa.org](http://web3.ncaa.org) and provide JAA with your NCAA ID.
7. All players must have a current physical signed by a Medical Doctor or Doctor of Orthopedics before participating in any sports.
8. Student-Athlete must submit Proof of Health Insurance.
9. JAA has partnered with fully accredited Doral College to provide ONLINE College classes (**School Code: 120039004071**). Admission requirements at Doral College are as follows: 1. Hold at minimum, a standard high school diploma or equivalent; 2. High school 2.0 GPA, and 3. Complete the application process, including signing an enrollment agreement.
10. Financial Aid is Available at Doral College for those who qualify (Florida Financial Aid, Florida Grants, Federal Student Aid, and or student loan).

11. All Student-Athletes MUST attend Summer School 2022 (Complete FAFSA for 2021/2022 AND 2022/2023). Summer classes starts August \_\_\_\_\_. Yes, you will start paying your out-of-pocket college costs for summer classes unless you've already received Pell grant funds or student loan.

12. Full Pell Grant (for those that qualify) is \$6,095.00 per year, \$2031.66 per quarter.

13. Doral College does not charge for textbooks and materials. The college provides free textbooks and materials online materials for each class to eliminate the cost of books.

14. Doral College provides study centers to help improve student learning.

15. A student registration liaison will be provided to assist students access the registration system.

16. Students are expected to have their own supplies including, note pads, planners, laptops, PCs, or iPads, printer, internet access, and appropriate word processing software.

17. JAA nor Doral College provides Room and Board.

18. Players must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA required for Doral College and meets required college courses that satisfies NCAA compliance requirements.
